This AMENDMENT E TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT (AMENDMENT E) is entered into this 14 day of July , 2023, by and between the PUERTO RICO DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING (PRDOH), a public agency of the Government of Puerto Rico created under Act No. 97, of June 10, 1972, as amended, 3 LPRA § 441 et seq., known as the "Department of Housing Organic Act" (Organic Act), with principal offices at 606 Barbosa Ave., San Juan, Puerto Rico, represented herein by its Secretary, Hon. William O. Rodríguez Rodríguez, of legal age, attorney, single, and resident of Guaynabo, Puerto Rico; and PATHSTONE CORPORATION (Subrecipient), a nonprofit corporation, with principal offices at 1235 Paseo Las Monjitas, Urb. Las Monjitas, Ponce, Puerto Rico, represented herein by its Director of Housing Programs, María G. Rodríguez Collazo, of legal age, single, and resident of Guayama, Puerto Rico; collectively the "Parties".

I. RECITALS AND GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2019, the Parties entered into a Subrecipient Agreement, registered as Contract Number 2020-DR0014 (Agreement), under the Housing Counseling Program (Program), for the total budget amount of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000.00), for a period of performance of twenty-four (24) months, ending on August 12, 2021.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2020, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient executed Amendment A to the Agreement, Contract Number 2020-DR0014A, to modify several items of Exhibit C (Key Personnel) and Exhibit D (Budget); also, to conform the Agreement to federal, state, and local regulations and statutes.

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2021, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient executed Amendment B to the Agreement, Contract Number 2020-DR0014B, principally to extend the period of performance, ending on July 31, 2023. Moreover, Exhibit D (Budget) was modified. The budget was increased to ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-SIX THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$1,796,778.00).

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2022, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient executed Amendment C to the Agreement, Contract Number 2020-DR0014C, principally to modify Exhibit D (Budget). The budget was increased to ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$1,865,783.00). Other modifications were incorporated into several terms and conditions of the Agreement, as well as its Exhibits.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2023, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient executed Amendment D to the Agreement, Contract Number 2020-DR0014D, principally to modify Exhibit C (Key Personnel) and Exhibit D (Budget). Moreover, an updated version of Exhibit F (HUD General Provisions and Other Federal Statutes, Regulations, and PRDOH Requirements) and a new Exhibit H (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) were incorporated. Other

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modifications were incorporated into several terms and conditions of the Agreement, as well as its Exhibits.

WHEREAS, as per Section IX (A) of the Agreement, the Agreement may be amended in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of each party. Nonetheless, the amendment shall not invalidate the Agreement, nor release the Parties from their obligations under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, this **AMENDMENT E** does not constitute an extinctive novation of the obligations of the parties under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, the PRDOH has the legal power and authority, in accordance with its enabling statute, the Organic Act, the Federal laws and regulations creating and allocating funds to the CDBG-DR Program and the current Action Plan, to enter into this **AMENDMENT E**.

WHEREAS, the Subrecipient has duly adopted the Resolution of the Board of Directors with identification No. 6, Series 2012, dated September 29, 2012, and Resolution of the Board of Directors with identification No. 7, Series 2020, approved on October 11, 2019, authorizing the Subrecipient by its Authorized Representative, María G. Rodríguez Collazo to enter into this AMENDMENT E with the PRDOH, and by signing this AMENDMENT E, the Subrecipient assures PRDOH that Subrecipient shall comply with all the requirements described herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and the terms and conditions set forth herein, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient agree to execute this **AMENDMENT E** subject to the following:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

II. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The information included in this **AMENDMENT E** serves the purpose of modifying and amending certain terms and conditions under the Agreement, including any modified Exhibits. All provisions of the original Agreement shall continue to be in full force and effect, as amended by this **AMENDMENT E**.

III. SCOPE OF THE AMENDMENT

This **AMENDMENT E** mainly entails a modification of the total budget amount as well as an extension of the period of performance of the Agreement. The budget is being increased for the amount of **NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS** (\$978,403.67) for a total budget amount of **TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS** (\$2,844,186.67). Furthermore, the period of performance of the Agreement will be extended for an additional twenty-four (24) months, ending on **July 31, 2025**. Other modifications are being incorporated into **Exhibit D** (Budget), as specified in the following section, and a new **Exhibit E-I** (Funds Certification) is incorporated by reference into the Agreement.

In addition, an updated **Exhibit H** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) is incorporated by reference into the Agreement. All other provisions of the original Agreement remain unaltered.

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IV. AMENDMENTS

A. The Parties agree to amend the **GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION** table as follows:

C. The Parties agree to amend **Article V. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM** to extend the term of the Subrecipient Agreement with the following:

V. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM

This Subrecipient Agreement shall be in effect and enforceable between the parties from the date of its execution. The performance period of this Subrecipient Agreement will end on **July 31, 2025.**

The End of Term shall be the later of: (i) July 31, 2025, (ii) the date as of which the Parties agree in writing that all Close-Out Requirements¹ have been satisfied or, where no Close-Out Requirements are applicable to this Agreement, the date as of which the Parties agree in writing that no Close-Out Requirements are applicable hereto; or (iii) such later date as the Parties may agree to in a signed amendment to this Agreement.

- D. **Exhibit D** (Budget) of the Agreement is being replaced by a modified **Exhibit D** (Budget) hereto incorporated by reference into the Agreement (See **Attachment I**). The aforementioned exhibit incorporates the following modifications.
 - On the Staffing section table:
 - Previous Expenditure (Staffing) has been increased from \$900, 134.50 to \$1,303,290.89,
 - Director of Housing Programs (1): The Month Needed [C] for this position is set at 24 and the Estimated Hours per Month per Resource is 48. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$90. 18 to \$92.25. As a result, the Estimated Max, Monthly Cost is \$4,428.00.
 - Regional Program Administrator (1): The Estimated Hours per Month per Resource has been reduced from 176 to 156. The Month Needed has been increased from 17 to 24. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$33.93 to \$34.34. As a result, the Estimated Max. The monthly cost has been reduced from \$5,972.00 to \$5,358.00.
 - Senior Housing Counselor (1): The Estimated Hours per Month per Resource has been increased from 120 to 156. The Month Needed has been increased from 17 to 24. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$33.62 to \$34.02. As a result, the Estimated Max. The monthly cost has increased from \$4,035.00 to \$5,308.00.





¹ "Close-Out Requirements" means all requirements to be satisfied by each party in order to close-out this Agreement and the CDBG-DR funds provided herein in accordance with applicable Requirements of Law, including the execution and delivery by one or more of the Parties of all close-out agreements or other legal instruments and the taking of any actions by one or more of the Parties in connection with such close-out, in any case as required under applicable Requirements of Law.

- Senior Housing Counselor (1): The Estimated Hours per Month per Resource has been reduced from 160 to 156. The Month Needed has been increased from 17 to 24. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$30.48 to \$30.85. As a result, the Estimated Max. The monthly cost has increased from \$4,877.00 to \$4,813.00.
- Senior Housing Counselor (1): The Estimated Hours per Month per Resource has been reduced from 168 to 156. The Month Needed has been increased from 17 to 24. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$27.90 to \$28.23. As a result, the Estimated Max. The monthly cost has increased from \$4,688.00 to \$4,404.00.
- Housing Counselor (1): The Estimated Hours per Month per Resource has been reduced from 168 to 156. The Month Needed has been increased from 17 to 24. The Estimated Hourly Rate has increased from \$25.36 to \$25.60. As a result, the Estimated Max. The monthly cost has been reduced from \$4,261.00 to \$3,994.00.
- The three (3) positions for Program Intake Specialist of Amendment D have had their Estimated Hourly Rate set at \$25.60 for **AMENDMENT E**, and an Estimated Hours per Month per Resource of 156, Estimated Max Monthly Cost for this position has been set at \$11,981.00.
- Additionally, a new Program Intake Specialist position has been added to AMENDMENT E. The Estimated Hourly Rate for this new Program Intake Specialist has been set at \$27.96, with an Estimated Hours per Month per Resource of 156 and an Estimated Max Monthly Cost of \$4,362.00.
- This AMENDMENT E has removed the Assistant position from Exhibit D (Budget).
- The Estimated Monthly Cost has been increased from \$39,041.00 (Amendment D) to \$44,648.00. As a result, the Total Cost for a new extension has increased from \$663,697.00 (Amendment D) to \$1,071,552.00 (Total cost for a new 2-year extension).
- Total Cost for Staffing in SRA has been increased from \$1,563,831.50 to \$2,374,842.89. This represents an increase of \$811,011.39 for AMENDMENT E.

On the Other Operating section:

- Previous Expenditures (Overhead) Line Item has increased from \$168,149,90 to \$243,669.06.
- Previous Expenditures (travel) Line Item has increased from \$3,165.84 to \$4,925.72.
- Overhead Line Item has been increased from \$121,422.00 to \$210,021.00.
- Equipment Line Item has been increased from \$6,485.76 to \$8,000.00.
- The Total Expenses for Amendment has increased from \$130,635.76 (Amendment D) to \$220,749.00 (Total Expenses for new 2-year extension).
- The Total Cost for Expenses in SRA has been increased from \$301,951,50 to \$469,343.78. This represents an increase of \$167,392.28 for AMENDMENT E.

• On the **Project Activity Delivery** section:

- Staffing increased from \$1,563,831.50 to \$2,374,842.89.
- Other Operating increased from \$301,951.50 to \$469,343.78.





- Grand Total increased from \$1,865,783.00 to \$2,844,186.67 in **AMENDMENT E** which represents an increase of \$978,403.67.
- E. Exhibit E-I (Funds Certification) is being incorporated by reference into the Agreement to reflect the budget increase of NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$978,403.67) incorporated via this AMENDMENT E. The new budget amount available to the SUBRECIPIENT to continue undertaking activities under the Program is TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$2,844,186.67). (See Attachment II).
- F. An updated **Exhibit H** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) is being incorporated by reference into the Agreement (See **Attachment III**).

V. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this **AMENDMENT E** is held invalid, the remainder of **AMENDMENT E** shall not be affected thereby, and all other parts of this **AMENDMENT E** shall nevertheless be in full force and effect.

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VI. SECTION HEADINGS AND SUBHEADINGS

The section headings and subheadings contained in this **AMENDMENT E** are included for convenience only and shall not limit or otherwise affect the terms of the Agreement, and shall not be used to explain, modify, simplify, or aid in the interpretation of the provisions of this **AMENDMENT E**.

VII. COMPTROLLER REGISTRY

The PRDOH shall remit a copy of this **AMENDMENT E** to the Office of the Comptroller for registration within **fifteen (15) days** following the date of execution of this **AMENDMENT E** and any subsequent amendment thereto. The services object of this **AMENDMENT E** may not be invoiced or paid until this **AMENDMENT E** has been registered by the PRDOH at the Comptroller's Office, pursuant to Act No. 18 of October 30, 1975, as amended by Act No. 127 of May 31, 2004.

VIII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The Agreement, as amended, constitutes the entire agreement among the Parties for the use of funds received under the Agreement, as amended, and it supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications and proposals, whether electronic, oral, or written among the Parties with respect to the Agreement, as amended.

IX. FEDERAL FUNDING

The fulfillment of the Agreement, as amended, is based on those funds being made available to the PRDOH as the lead administrative agency for Recovery. All expenditures under the Agreement, as amended, must be made in accordance with the Agreement, as amended, the policies and procedures promulgated under the CDBG-DR Program, and any other applicable laws. Further, the Subrecipient acknowledges that all funds are subject to recapture and repayment for non-compliance.
