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This AMENDMENT C TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT (AMENDMENT C) is entered into this 23 day of December 2024, by and between the PUERTO RICO DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING (PRDOH), a public agency of the Government of Puerto Rico created under Act No. 97, of June 10, 1972, as amended, 3 LPRA § 441 et seq., known as the "Department of Housing Organic Act" (Organic Act), with principal offices at 606 Barbosa Ave., San Juan, Puerto Rico, represented herein by its Secretary, Hon. William O. Rodríguez Rodríguez, of legal age, attorney, single, and resident of Guaynabo, Puerto Rico; and the Municipality of Mayagüez (Subrecipient), a local government legal entity, with principal offices at Mayagüez Puerto Rico, represented herein by its Acting Mayor, Jorge Luis Ramos Ruíz of legal age, married, and resident of Mayagüez, Puerto Rico; duly authorized to represent the Municipality by the provisions of the Puerto Rico Municipal Code, Law No. 107 of August 14, 2020, collectively the "Parties".

I. RECITALS AND GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2021, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient executed a Memorandum of Understanding, registered as Contract Number 2022-DR0098 (Agreement), for ONE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHT DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-FOUR CENTS (\$194,908.84) to provide the Subrecipient with the capacity to successfully assume the delegated functions, including recruiting resources that will be in charge of carrying out administrative tasks related to programmatic compliance efforts. The Parties agreed on a performance period of twenty-four (24) months from the day of the execution of the Agreement, ending on August 6, 2023.

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2023, the Parties agreed to amend the Agreement through Amendment A, registered as Contract Number 2022-DR0098A, to extend the term for an additional twelve (12) months, ending on August 06, 2024, and to clarify that the Agreement that was executed between them should have been named Subrecipient Agreement instead of Memorandum of Understanding, Modifications to Section III. GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION table, Section IV. ATTACHMENTS, Section VII. EFFECTIVE DATE AND THE TERM, Section XII. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL STATUTES, REGULATIONS, AND THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE FEDERAL AWARD AND ADDITIONAL PROOH REQUIREMENTS, and Section XIII. CDBG-DR POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, were included. Also, Section XXXV. SYSTEM FOR AWARD MANAGEMENT (SAM) REGISTRATION, and Section XXXVI. LIMITATIONS PENDING ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE were added to the Agreement. Furthermore, updated version of Exhibit C (HUD General Provisions and Other Federal Statutes, Regulations, and PRDOH Requirements), and a new **Exhibit D** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) were incorporated by reference into the Agreement. All other provisions of the original Agreement, including the total budget amount, remained unaltered.

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2024, the Parties agreed to amend the Agreement through Amendment B, registered as Contract Number 2022-DR0098B, to extend the term ending on December 31, 2024. Modifications to Section III. GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION

table, Section VII. EFFECTIVE DATE AND THE TERM, were included. Also, Section XXXVII. PUERTO RICO POLITICAL CAMPAIGN FINANCING OVERSIGHT ACT was added to the Agreement. Furthermore, updated versions of Exhibit C (HUD General Provisions and Other Federal Statutes, Regulations, and PRDOH Requirements), and Exhibit D (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) were incorporated by reference into the Agreement. All other provisions of the original Agreement, including the total budget amount, remained unaltered.

WHEREAS, as per Section IX (A) of the Agreement, the Agreement may be amended in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of each party. Nonetheless, the amendment shall not invalidate the Agreement, nor release the Parties from their obligations under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, this AMENDMENT C does not constitute an extinctive novation of the obligations of the parties under the Agreement.

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WHEREAS, the PRDOH has the legal power and authority, in accordance with its enabling statute, the Organic Act, the Federal laws and regulations creating and allocating funds to the CDBG-DR Program, and the current Action Plan, to enter into this **AMENDMENT C**.

WHEREAS, the Subrecipient has the legal power and authority to enter into this AMENDMENT C with the PRDOH, in accordance with Article 1.008(q) of Act No. 107 of August 14, 2020, also known as the "Puerto Rico Municipal Code", 21 LPRA § 7013(q); and by signing this AMENDMENT C, the Subrecipient assures the PRDOH that it shall comply with all the requirements described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and the terms and conditions set forth herein, the PRDOH and the Subrecipient agree to execute this **AMENDMENT C** subject to the following:

II. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The information included in this **AMENDMENT C** serves the purpose of modifying and amending certain terms and conditions under the Agreement, as well as modifying or incorporating several exhibits, as established in the following sections B and C of this **AMENDMENT C**. All other provisions of the original Agreement, including its exhibits, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

B. SCOPE OF THE AMENDMENT

The Parties acknowledge and agree that this **AMENDMENT C** entails a modification of the **PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE** and **END DATE** of the Agreement. To achieve the Program goals, the Parties acknowledge and agree that it is necessary to amend the **END TERM** of the Agreement to **December 31, 2025**.

Also, modifications and changes to the **GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION** table in **Section III**, **VII**. **EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM**, and **Section XVI**. **CONSOLIDATIONS**, **MERGERS**, **CHANGE OF NAME**, **OR DISSOLUTIONS** of the Agreement are being incorporated via this **AMENDMENT C**.

Finally, an updated version of **Exhibit D** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) is incorporated by reference into the Agreement. All other provisions of the original Agreement, including the total budget amount, remain unaltered.

 Section VII. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM of the Agreement is being amended as follows:

This Agreement shall be in effect and enforceable between the parties from the date of its execution. The performance period of this Agreement extends from the date of its execution, ending on **December 31**, **2025**.

The End of Term shall be the later of: (i) **December 31, 2025**; (ii) the date as of which the Parties agree in writing that all Close-Out Requirements¹ have been satisfied or, where no Close-Out Requirements are applicable to this Agreement, the date as of which the Parties agree in writing that no Close-Out Requirements are applicable hereto; or (iii) such later date as the Parties may agree to in a signed amendment to this Agreement.

- c. The Parties agree to amend **Section XVI. CONSOLIDATIONS**, **MERGERS**, **CHANGE OF NAME**, **OR DISSOLUTIONS**, as follows:
 - A. Consolidation or Merger

Upon the consolidation or the merger becoming effective and supporting evidence of such event is notified to PRDOH, execution of an Amendment to the Agreement may follow. The Amendment would include, but not be limited to, modifications to the clauses that refer to the identity, personal circumstances, address, and any other information related to the signing party deemed relevant by PRDOH for the execution of the Amendment. No amendment to the Agreement will be necessary if the Subrecipient, Contractor, or Subcontractor becomes the surviving entity following a merger.

Failure to comply with any of the before-mentioned conditions may result in the activation of the termination clauses provided in the Agreement.

B. Change of Name

In the event that the signing party (e.g., Subrecipient, Contractor, or Subcontractor) of the Agreement with the PRDOH initiates a change of name process, written notice of such decision or event shall be delivered to the PRDOH Legal Division at contractscabgdr@vivienda.pr.gov at least fifteen (15) days prior to the effective date of such event. The notice shall include, but not be limited to, a description of: the expected effective date of the change of name; the proposed name; notify about inform of any change of address; and reference of any change in the capacity of the entity to comply with the terms, conditions, obligations, tasks, services, and performance goals or requirements included in the Agreement, as well as its Exhibits or Attachments.

Upon the change of name becoming effective and supporting evidence of such event is notified to PRDOH, execution of an Amendment to the Agreement may follow. The Amendment would include, but not limited to, modifications to the clauses that refer to the identity, personal circumstances, address, and any other information related to the signing party deemed relevant by PRDOH for the execution of the Amendment. Failure to comply with any of the before-mentioned conditions may result in the activation of the termination clauses provided in the Agreement.

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In the event that the signing party (e.g., Subrecipient, Contractor, or Subcontractor) of the Agreement with the PRDOH moves for dissolution of the entity, written notice of such decision or event shall be delivered to the PRDOH Legal Division at contractscdbadr@vivienda.pr.gov at least fifteen (15) days prior to the effective date of such event. The notice shall include, but not be limited to, a description of the expected effective date of the dissolution; and contact information of one or more of its directors, officials, or agents. Upon dissolution becoming effective and supporting evidence of such event is notified to PRDOH, termination of the Agreement will follow. Consequently, the signing party acknowledges and agrees to provide to the PRDOH, after termination of the Agreement, the assistance reasonably requested to facilitate the orderly transfer of responsibility for the performance of the tasks or services to the PRDOH or a third party designated by the PRDOH. Moreover, all finished or unfinished records (files, data, work product) connected with this Agreement will be turned over to PRDOH following the Agreement termination.



d. **Exhibit D** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification) of the Agreement is being replaced by an updated version. (See **Attachment I**).

III. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this **AMENDMENT C** is held invalid, the remainder of **AMENDMENT C** shall not be affected thereby, and all other parts of this **AMENDMENT C** shall nevertheless be in full force and effect.

IV. SECTION HEADINGS AND SUBHEADINGS

The section headings and subheadings contained in this **AMENDMENT C** are included for convenience only and shall not limit or otherwise affect the terms of the Agreement, and shall not be used to explain, modify, simplify, or aid in the interpretation of the provisions of this **AMENDMENT C**.

V. COMPTROLLER REGISTRY

The PRDOH shall remit a copy of this **AMENDMENT C** to the Office of the Comptroller for registration within **fifteen (15) days** following the date of execution of this **AMENDMENT C** and any subsequent amendment thereto. The services object of this **AMENDMENT C** may not be invoiced or paid until this **AMENDMENT C** has been registered by the PRDOH at the Comptroller's Office, under Act No. 18 of October 30, 1975, as amended by Act No. 127 of May 31, 2004.

VI. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The Agreement, as amended, constitutes the entire Agreement among the Parties for the use of funds received under the Agreement, as amended, and it supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications and proposals, whether electronic, oral, or written among the Parties concerning the Agreement, as amended.

VII. FEDERAL FUNDING

The fulfillment of the Agreement, as amended, is based on those funds being made available to the PRDOH as the lead administrative agency for Recovery. All expenditures under the Agreement, as amended, must be made in accordance with the Agreement, as amended, the policies and procedures promulgated under the CDBG-DR Program, and any other applicable laws. Further, the Subrecipient acknowledges that all funds are subject to recapture and repayment for non-compliance.



VIII. NON-CONFLICT OF INTEREST CERTIFICATION

The Subrecipient reassurances PRDOH of its willingness to comply with the applicable conflict of interest policies by signing the Non-Conflict of Interest Certification incorporated by reference into the Agreement by this **AMENDMENT C (ATTACHMENT I)**.

Rodríguez Rodríguez, attorney, of legal age, single, and resident of Guaynabo, Puerto Rico, in his capacity as Secretary; and OPPENHEIMER, LLC (CONTRACTOR), with principal offices in 623 Ave. Ponce de León, San Juan, Puerto Rico, herein represented by Miguel Oppenheimer Ríos, in his capacity as Principal Member, of legal age, married, and resident of Guaynabo, Puerto Rico duly authorized by Corporate Resolution issued on

I. RECITALS AND GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION

March 16, 2023, collectively, the Parties.

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2023, the PRDOH and the CONTRACTOR entered into an Agreement for Hearing Examiner Services, registered under Contract No. 2023-DR0100, for a maximum amount not to exceed SIX HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$691,200.00); from Account Number: MITA12ADM-DOH-NA 4190-10-000/R01A01ADM-DOH-NA 4190-10-000, ending on March 27, 2025 (Agreement).

WHEREAS, as per Article XL of the Agreement, the Agreement may be amended in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of each party. Nonetheless, the amendment shall not invalidate the Agreement, nor release the Parties from their obligations under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, this Amendment A is not intended to affect nor does it constitute an extinctive novation of the obligations of the Parties under the Agreement, but is rather a modification and amendment of certain terms and conditions under the Agreement.

WHEREAS, each party represents that the person executing this Amendment has the necessary legal authority to do so on behalf of the respective party.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement, as amended, and become subject to the terms of the Agreement, as amended, and this Amendment A.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and the terms and conditions set forth herein, the PRDOH and the CONTRACTOR agree as follows:





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

II. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The information included in this Amendment serves the purpose of modifying and amending certain terms and conditions under the Agreement, as established in the following Articles III and IV of this Amendment. All other provisions of the original Agreement, including its attachments, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

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III. SCOPE OF AMENDMENT

The Legal Division has identified the need to amend the Agreement to extend the performance period to ensure continuity, efficiency, and stability in the agency's administrative processes. As a result, the Legal Division has determined to extend the term of the agreement for an additional twelve (12) months, for a total of thirty-six (36) months, ending on March 27, 2026. This adjustment guarantees the continuity of essential services and provides an effective solution to address the current and future needs of the programs. Moreover, the Parties agreed to amend ARTICLE II. TERM OF AGREEMENT ARTICLE XXVIII. CDBG-DR/MIT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, and ARTICLE XLVI. CONSOLIDATIONS, MERGERS, CHANGE OF NAME, OR DISSOLUTIONS.

Lastly, Amendment A includes updated versions of **Attachment F** (HUD General Provisions), **Attachment G** (Contractor Certification), and **Attachment H** (Non-Conflict of Interest Certification). All other provisions, including the budget, remain unaltered.

IV. AMENDMENTS

A. The Parties agree to amend ARTICLE II. TERM OF AGREEMENT, as follows:

This Agreement shall be in effect and enforceable between the parties from the date of its execution. The Term of this Agreement will be for a performance period of **thirty-six (36) months**, ending on **March 27, 2026**.

B. The Parties agree to amend Article XXVIII. CDBG-DR/MIT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES as follows:

In addition to what is established in this Agreement, the CONTRACTOR shall comply with all CDBG-DR program-specific and general policies and procedures, which may include but are not limited to, the Subrecipient Management Policy, OS&H Guideline, MWBE Policy, URA & ADP Guidelines, Cross Cutting Guidelines, AFWAM Policy, Section 3 Policy, Language Access Plan, Personally Identifiable Information, Confidentiality, and Nondisclosure Policy and Conflict of Interest and Standards of Conduct Policy, as found in the CDBG-DR Website (https://cdbg-dr.pr.gov/en/resources/policies/), which are herein included and made an integral part of this SRA, as they may be updated from time to time, Procurement policies and procedures in accordance with the federal procurement rules and regulations found in 2 C.F.R. § 200.318 through §200.327, and reporting requirements as established by the PRDOH.

C. The Parties agree to amend Article XLVI. CONSOLIDATIONS, MERGERS, CHANGE OF NAME, OR DISSOLUTIONS as follows:

The fulfillment of the Agreement, as amended, is based on those funds being made available to the PRDOH as the lead administrative agency for Recovery. All expenditures under the Agreement, as amended, must be made in accordance with the Agreement, as amended, the policies and procedures promulgated under the CDBG-DR/MIT Programs, and any other applicable laws. Further, the CONTRACTOR acknowledges that all funds are subject to recapture and repayment for non-compliance.

VII. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

It is the intention and understanding of the Parties hereto that each and every provision of law required to be inserted in the Agreement, as amended, should be and is inserted herein. Furthermore, it is hereby stipulated that every such provision is deemed to be inserted and if, through mistake or otherwise, any such provision is not inserted herein or





is not inserted in correct form, then the Agreement, as amended, shall forthwith, upon the application of any Party, be amended by such insertion so as to comply strictly with the law and without prejudice to the rights of any Party.

VIII. SUBROGATION

The CONTRACTOR acknowledges that funds provided through the Agreement, as amended, are Federal funds administered by HUD under the CDBG-DR/MIT Program and that all funds provided by the Agreement, as amended, are subject to audit, disallowance, and repayment. Any disagreement with adverse findings may be challenged and subject to Federal regulation, however, the CONTRACTOR shall promptly return any and all funds to the PRDOH, which are found to be ineligible, unallowable, unreasonable, a duplication of benefits, or non-compensable, no matter the cause. This clause shall survive indefinitely the termination of the Agreement, as amended.

IX. COMPTROLLER REGISTRY

The PRDOH shall remit a copy of this Amendment to the Office of the Comptroller for registration within **fifteen (15)** days following the date of execution of this Amendment and any subsequent amendment thereto. The services object of this Amendment may not be invoiced or paid until this Amendment has been registered by the PRDOH at the Comptroller's Office, pursuant to Act No. 18 of October 30, 1975, as amended by Act No. 127 of May 31, 2004.

X. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The Agreement and this Amendment constitute the entire agreement among the Parties for the use of funds received under the Agreement and this Amended Agreement and it supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications and proposals, whether electronic, oral or written among the Parties with respect to the agreement.

XI. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Amendment shall operate or would prospectively operate to invalidate the Amendment in whole or in part, then such provision only shall be deemed severed and the remainder of the Amendment shall remain operative and in full effect.

XII. COUNTERPARTS

This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, however, all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. If the Amendment is not executed by the PRDOH within **thirty (30)** days of execution by the other party, this Amendment shall be null and void.

XIII. SURVIVAL OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions of this Amendment related to the following subjects shall survive the termination or expiration of this Amendment: interpretive provisions; consideration; warranties; general affirmations, federal assurances, federal and state certifications; CDBG-DR/MIT and state funding, recapture of CDBG-DR/MIT and/or state funds, overpayment of CDBG-DR/MIT and/or state funds; ownership and intellectual property, copyright; records retention methods and time requirements; inspection, monitoring, and audit; confidentiality; public records; indemnification and liability; infringement of intellectual property rights; independent contractor relationship; compliance with laws; notices; choice of law and venue; severability; dispute resolution; consolidations, merger, change of name, and dissolution. Terms and conditions that, explicitly or by their nature, evidence the Parties' intent that they should survive the termination or expiration of this Amendment shall so survive.
